The purpose of this project was to perform a boundary survey of approximately 900 Acres in Fleming County. In the first phase 484 Acres of the Francis P. Browning heirs property was surveyed and was conveyed to the Park Lake Mountain Preserve. It was completed within the 90 day project schedule. Howerton Engineering established the boundary of the aforementioned properties, and also established the boundaries of two parcels to be retained by the Browning family.

The second phase of the project was a boundary survey of the Clifton and Aline Gulley property, containing approximately 378 Acres was performed. The second phase was completed within the 90 day project schedule, in 2007. A plat identifying both subject parcels was prepared for display purposes. Additionally ESRI shape files were distributed for use by the user agency. All monuments were set meeting Finance Cabinet Standards using 3 inch stamped aluminum markers set in concrete.

Deliverables consisted of signed original bond print, CAD DWG, and PDF files of the survey.
