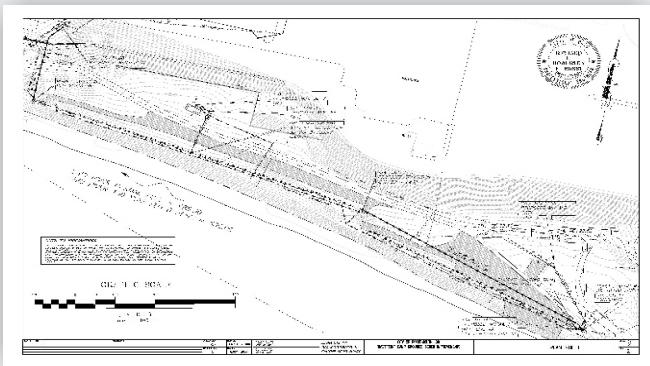

Project Description:

Due to leaching of the cities septic and leach system that serves the campgrounds the Ohio EPA mandated sanitary sewer extension to the campgrounds. The scope of the project consisted of designing two sanitary sewer lift stations, sanitary sewer forcemains, and sanitary sewer gravity extensions. The project consisted of approximately 2,000 linear feet of forcemain, 1,000 linear feet of gravity sewer, and multiple manholes. The project consisted of obtaining permits from the Ohio EPA as well as the US Army Corp of Engineers



Huntington, WV district due the forcemain being extended through the flood wall. Howerton Engineering performed these services for the City of Portsmouth on budget and on time.

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
